

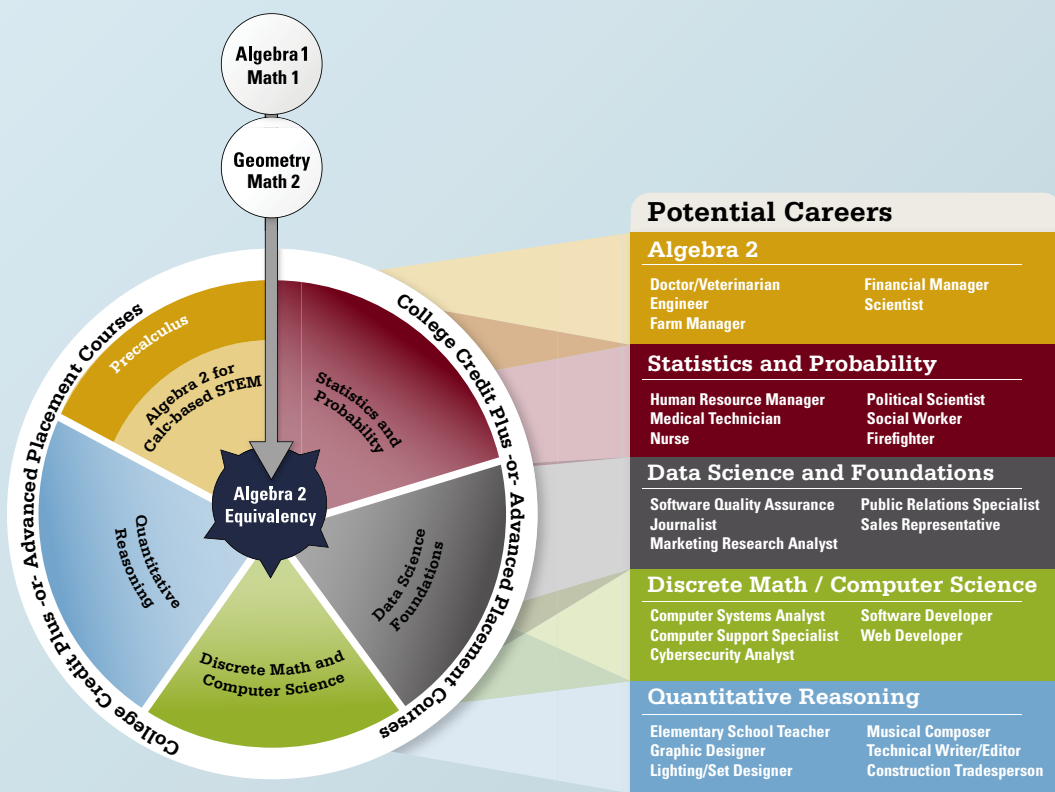
Strengthening Ohio's High School Math Pathways Virtual Symposium
